Pre-season testing for the Formula BMW Pacific Series has proven a crucial element in the preparation of successful drivers in previous seasons.

Three circuits are used, the full F1 Grand Prix Circuit and the South or North Circuits (southern/northern half of the Grand Prix Circuit, both ideal testing circuits). Sepang is close to the Kuala Lumpur airport and to several 3 and 5 star hotels.

The team have our Formula BMW Pacific test cars permanently based at Sepang allowing us to offer year round practice on a World Class Circuit.

BMW SCHOLARSHIP TRAINING

Each year BMW offer up to three 50,000 Euro Scholarships to drivers participating in Formula BMW Pacific. Trials are held at the Sepang F1 Circuit in Malaysia. In 2009 they were held in September over two days, the 2010 date will be announced soon.

PRE-SEASON F.BMW TESTING

Previous seasons have demonstrated that in order to be competitive from the first event a driver must undertake pre-season testing. A minimum of ten days is recommended. Under the series regulations a test ban will come into force approximately one month prior to the first event of the season therefore drivers must plan ahead to ensure they undertake sufficient practice.

We can tailor a training program to suit the driver's experience and it may be staggered over several months or even one year.

Eurasia is renowned for training new drivers. 2009 British F3 Champion and Red Bull F1 Reserve Driver, Daniel Ricciardo, states "Eurasia gave me the best possible grounding and training which has allowed me to develop into a truly competitive driver".
